EXPERIENCE: Bachelor's degree in ecology, botany, biology, natural resources or other closely related field. Five years experience necessary to gain full understanding of natural communities native to northeastern Illinois and methods for restoration and management of damaged ecosystems, knowledge of the standard sources of information in natural area management and ecological restoration, proficiency in the preparation and writing of reports, restoration plans, management schedules, and ecological impact assessments and project contracts.
